Assessment of Readiness

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Our students take federally-required assessments every spring. These assessments help us understand how our students are growing academically, compared to their peers across the state. The state uses this information to provide more support and resources to the schools in the greatest need. This year, the English/Language Arts and Math assessment for grades 3-8 is called the **Illinois Assessment of Readiness**.

The Illinois Assessment of Readiness measures the same Illinois Learning Standards and includes the same high-quality test questions that teachers and students have become familiar with over the past four years.

Our students should feel confident showing what they know and can do on the Illinois Assessment of Readiness.

Our students in grades 3-8 will take the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) April 4-8. Make-up tests will be April 11-13.
